Purpose of Establishing Majlis Atfal-ul-Ahmadiyya

While explaining the purpose and objective of establishing Majlis Atfal-ul-Ahmadiyya, Hazrat Khalifatul Masih V (may Allah be his Helper) once said:

“Atfal-ul-Ahmadiyya is such an organisation of the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community on which the future depends. The children of today become the youth of tomorrow and the leaders of the nation. Thus, when Hazrat Khalifatul Masih II (may Allah be pleased with him) established various organisations, he also formed an organisation for children under Khuddam-ul-Ahmadiyya, which came to be known as Atfal-ul-Ahmadiyya.

Hence, Atfal-ul-Ahmadiyya is a very important organisation. When Hazrat Khalifatul Masih II formed all these organisations, his intention was that every child, youth, elderly person, woman, and man of the Community should become capable of shouldering the responsibilities of the Jama'at.”

This guidance of Huzoor Anwar serves as a torchbearer for all members of Majilis Atfal in India. Alhamdulillah, all Majalis across India, following the instructions of the Markaz and in light of the directives of Syedna Huzoor Anwar, prepare various programmes throughout the year for the religious education and moral training of Khuddam and Atfal in accordance with the guidelines of Majlis Khuddam-ul-Ahmadiyya.

This year, with the intention of further improving the educational and moral training of the Atfal members in India, as well as their physical and mental development, the Atfal Department of the Majlis Khuddam-ul-Ahmadiyya India has prepared this concise annual programme for the convenience of Nazimeen Atfal and members of the Majilis Atfal-ul-Ahmadiyya India. Using this as guidance, Nazimeen Atfal can organise various tarbiyyat, academic, intellectual, and physical activities in their respective Majilis.

Departments of Majlis Atfal-ul-Ahmadiyya

To further improve the functioning of Majilis Atfal-ul-Ahmadiyya, and according to the rules, the tasks related to the Atfal department have been divided into the following departments. In the Majilis, the supervision of these departments are called *Mu'tamids* (departmental in-charges). Who carry out their respective responsibilities under the supervision of the Nazim Atfal.

1. General Affairs
2. Tajneed (Membership renewal)
3. Tarbiyyat (Moral Training)
4. Taleem (Education)
5. Maal (Finance)

6. Waqf-e-Jadid
7. Waqar-e-Amal (Dignity of Labour)
8. Khidmat-e-Khalq (Service to Humanity)
9. Sehat-e-Jismani (Physical Health)
10. San‘at-o-Tijarat (Industry & Trade)
11. Isha‘at (Publications)

It is the duty of Nazimeen Atfal that, at the beginning of the year, they form their Majilis Aamila while keeping all these departments in view, and send it through the Qaid Majilis to the Markaz for approval, so that the approval of the Majilis Aamila can be issued promptly by the centre.

Therefore, those Majalis that have not yet obtained the approval of the Majilis Aamila Atfal-ul-Ahmadiyya must immediately contact the Muhtamim Atfal at the Markaz and complete the process of forming their Majilis Aamila.

Muhtamim Atfal

Majlis Khuddam-ul-Ahmadiyya India

General Affairs (amoomi)

The responsibility of this department is to ensure that, in accordance with the guidance and annual plan of Markaz, all Majalis regularly organize educational, moral, and physical programmes should be regularly held for Atfal in all Majalis.

- Monthly Reports:

All monthly reports must be completed and submitted to the Nazim Atfal and the Qaid Majlis. After being signed by both, the reports should be sent to the Atfal Department of Majlis Khuddam-ul-Ahmadiyya India by the 5th of the following month.

- Email Submission:

Since email services are now easily accessible, Nazimeen Atfal are instructed to regularly complete the prescribed report forms and send them via email. All reports and related correspondence should be sent to the following email addresses

Co-ordination with Markaz:

For the effective education and training of Atfal, Nazimeen Atfal should maintain regular communication with the central Atfal Department and keep them informed about the activities taking place in their Majilis. It is advised that Nazimeen Atfal contact the Muhtamim Atfal or other office-bearers of Majlis Amla Atfal-ul-Ahmadiyya India **at least once each month** so that the central department remains updated on the progress of the Majilis and can offer timely guidance.

- Annual Reports:

All Majilis are required to submit a detailed annual report of their activities to Markaz by **15th July**. Nazimeen Atfal are requested to send monthly performance reports consistently and ensure that the complete annual report for the year reaches Markaz by **15th July 2026**.

- Record of the Majilis

All Nazimeen Atfal should review within their respective Majilis whether proper arrangements exist for preserving the necessary records to correspondence and the work of the Majilis. Every Majilis must have the following registers and files kept with the General Secretary for maintaining the Majilis records:

1. Meeting minutes Register

2. Inventory Register
3. Membership (Tajneed) Register
4. Daily ledger for entering Majlis Chanda contributions
5. File for monthly reports
6. File for circulars
7. File for correspondence
8. Individual files for all departments

Tajneed (Membership renewal Department)

All following details of the Atfal of the Majlis must be recorded in the Tajneed Register:

- Full Name and Jamaat Card Number
- Father's Name
- Date of Birth
- Education
- Address
- Knowledge of Qaida Yassarnal Qur'an?
- Can recite the Qur'an with Nazira?
- Completed Nazira of the Qur'an?
- Can offer simple Salah?
- Can offer Salah with translation?
- Member of Waqf-e-Nau? If yes, note reference number
- Member of Waqf-e-Jadid or other financial schemes?

Majilis that have not yet completed their Tajneed and submitted it to Markaz are requested to complete this work and submit it by 15th December.

Tarbiyat (Moral Training Department)

This year, special attention should be given to the training of Atfal in every Majlis.

Efforts should be made to ensure that all Atfal of the Majlis:

- Offer congregational prayers regularly
- Observe supplications and prayers
- Practice truthfulness and honesty
- Show respect for parents, teachers, and elders
- Demonstrate good manners and etiquettes, following Majlis rules

Monthly Tarbiyyati Meetings

- Each Majlis should hold a monthly training session attended by 100% of Atfal.
- During these sessions, scholars and senior members should guide Atfal on moral, spiritual, and practical matters.

Appointment of Atfal Mentor (Murabbi)

- Every Majlis must appoint at least one Murabbi from among Ansar members to oversee the education and training of Atfal, in accordance with the constitution and annual plan.
- Nazimeen Atfal should review potential candidates and submit at least three proposed names along with brief profiles and contact details to the Atfal Department of Majlis Khuddam-ul-Ahmadiyya India.
- Majlis where Murabbi appointments have already been made at the start of the year must send the details of the appointed Murabbi to the department as soon as possible.

Atfal Pledge (Wa'dah-e-Atfal)

Efforts should be made this year to ensure that all Atfal memorize the Atfal Pledge by heart.

Pattern for Monthly Tarbiyyati Sessions

To increase Atfal engagement, all Majalis should follow the following tarbiyyati session pattern:

1. Recitation of the Holy Qur'an with translation

2. Recitation of the Atfal Pledge
3. Presentation of selected poems(nazms) of the Promised Messiah (as) or the Khulafa
4. Translation and explanation of difficult words by an Atfal
5. Short speeches by 2 Atfal on various moral and educational topics
6. Presentation of selected events from the life of Hazrat Amirul Momineen (aba) from the diary of Mr. Abid Khan (Press Secretary)
7. Research presentation by an Atfal on an engaging topic
8. Q&A session on the speeches delivered
9. Session ends with a Dua

Training Classes during School Holidays

Every Majlis must arrange at least weekly or three-day training classes during the seasonal holidays this year. In these classes, the Waqf-e-Nau syllabus should be used to assess and improve the education and moral training of Atfal. After conducting these classes, a separate report of the activities must be sent to the Markaz.

Attendance System

Majilis should make efforts to ensure that Atfal:

- offer Salat in congregation,
- listen to the Friday Sermon of Huzoor Anwar (aba) on MTA,
- and regularly attend other Majlis programs such as educational classes, tarbiyyati meetings, Waqar-e-Amal, etc.
- For this purpose, it is advisable that the Nazim Atfal maintains a proper attendance system for congregational prayers as well as the programs mentioned above.

If, in cities, due to long distances between homes and the mosque, attendance for congregational prayers is not possible, then Majilis must ensure that parents supervise these matters at home and maintain daily attendance, and at the end of the month provide this report/information to the Nazim Atfal.

Benefit from MTA

- Majalis should review how many Atfal benefit from various MTA programs. Those Atfal who do not benefit—or have very little exposure—should be reminded and encouraged.
- If the number of Atfal in a Majlis is small and proper MTA arrangements are not available in homes, then it is essential to have MTA arrangements in the mosque.
- Majalis should arrange to gather Atfal in the mosque on Fridays and Sunday mornings to watch MTA programs. Similarly, MTA broadcasts special programs for teaching Urdu and for Story Time/Play Time for children, such as "Bachon Ki Dunya". These programs should also be shown to Atfal from time to time.
- These programs are also available on MTA Online (YouTube channel).
- In addition, the Jamaat publishes the newspaper Al-Fazl, which should also be used for the benefit of Atfal.

Moral Development (Basic Moral Qualities)

Majalis should strive to inculcate the following five moral qualities in all Atfal:

1. Truthfulness
2. Use of soft and pure speech
3. Compassion for creation — feeling the pain of others and helping relieve it
4. Broad-mindedness and tolerance
5. Strong determination and courage

Similarly, every effort should be made to eliminate the following evils from among Atfal:

Efforts should also be made to eliminate the following vices:

- Lying, backbiting, foul language, fighting
- Disobedience, idleness, wasting time
- Theft, dishonesty, bad company, intoxicants
- Improper dressing, excessive use of mobile phones

Spreading Peace – (Afshu al-Salaam)

In accordance with the instruction of the Holy Prophet ﷺ “Afshu al-salaam” (spread peace), children should be trained to greet and shake hands with everyone—young and old.

Letters for Prayers

Each Majlis should ensure that every Tifl writes at least one letter per month to Huzoor Anwar (aba) requesting prayers.

Parents’ Day

Every Majlis should hold Parents’ Day twice a year, in which all Atfal, their parents, and other Jamaat members should participate.

During this event, the proceedings should follow the prescribed pattern of tarbiyyati meetings. The presiding officer should draw the attention of Atfal and their parents to various important matters of training and moral upbringing.

Atfal Week

According to the program of the Markazi Annual Ijtema, each Majlis should hold Atfal Week once a year. During this week, various educational and sports competitions should be organized for Atfal.

Additionally, a special session should be held focused on attachment to Khilafat, in which incidents from the blessed life of Huzoor Anwar (aba) — taken from the diary of Respected Abid Khan Sahib (Press Secretary, Jamaat Ahmadiyya) — should be narrated to the Atfal to increase their interest.

To increase the interest of Atfal, a discussion programme should also be held occasionally, in which only Atfal participate.

A general knowledge quiz and Waqf-e-Nau syllabus-based quiz should also be organized, and a detailed report with photographs should be sent to the Markaz.

Kuloo Jamee'an & Picnics

Every Majlis should arrange Kuloo Jamee'an (collective meals) at least three times a year, and efforts should be made to ensure that all Atfal participate in this program.

Summary of Friday Sermons

- All Atfal should be encouraged to listen live to the Friday Sermon of Huzoor Anwar (aba) every Friday and write notes of the sermon in their diaries.
- Throughout the year, Atfal who regularly prepare summaries and notes should be awarded prizes at the annual District or State Ijtema.
- A report of this activity should also be sent to the Markaz.

Visit to Qadian Dar-ul-Aman

Majalis should encourage the Atfal of the senior age group to visit Qadian Dar-ul-Aman during seasonal holidays.

For this, a district-level program may also be organized. Atfal from the district can be prepared and brought to Qadian during the holidays.

Taleem (Education) Department

Academic Competitions

To enhance children's knowledge and abilities, at least two competitions should be held during the year in the Majlis, including:

- Qur'an recitation
- Poetry (nazm) recitation
- Speeches
- Quizzes
- Memorization contests
- Message delivery competitions, etc.

Teaching of the Holy Quran

- All Atfal members should be taught Qaida Yasna Al-Qur'an and Nazirah of the Holy Qur'an in the Majlis.
- Children who complete Nazirah during the year should have their names sent to Markaz to receive certificates of recognition.
- Majalis should also ensure that all Atfal memorize the first 17 verses of Surah Al-Baqarah and short Surahs from Juz Amma.

Religious Curriculum Examination

- Efforts should be made to include all Atfal in the annual Religious Curriculum Exam.
- Question papers will be sent to Majalis from Markaz.
- The exam will be conducted twice a year according to the Waqf-e-Nau curriculum, so Majalis should ensure proper preparation of children as per the syllabus.

Essay Competition

This year, essay competitions will be organized for Atfal-ul-Ahmadiyya according to the following schedule:

First Half of the year

1. Existence of Allah
2. Birth and Childhood of the Holy Prophet (SAW)
3. Five Fundamental Moral Qualities

Second Half of the year

1. Life of the Promised Messiah (as)
2. Khilafat – A Great Blessing
3. Organization of Majlis Atfal-ul-Ahmadiyya

Guidelines for Essay Writing:

- Aim for at least 50% participation of Atfal aged 12 and above.
- Essays must be at least 1500 words and written in Urdu, English, Hindi, or any regional language of India.
- Write neatly on two-thirds of the page; do not write on the back.
- Include complete and authentic references (book name, author, volume, page number, year, place of publication).
- The top 5 essays will receive cash prizes.
- Students must include on the first page: name, Majlis name, full address, phone number, and other necessary details.

- Essays should be submitted to Majlis Qaid, who will forward them to the Office of Majlis Khuddam-ul-Ahmadiyya India.
- Submission deadlines:
 - First Half: 1st April 2026
 - Second Half: 1st July 2026

Coaching Classes (for 8th to 10th Grade Students)

Free coaching classes should be organized in the months of January and February with the cooperation of Majlis Khuddam-ul-Ahmadiyya, so that our children can achieve excellent marks in their academic studies.

Special Training Classes

Regarding further education after Matric, a special meeting should be held in January with students above the 6th class, with the cooperation of Majlis Khuddam-ul-Ahmadiyya. In this meeting, they should be encouraged to prepare themselves according to the growing needs of the Jama'at.

Introduction to Jamia Ahmadiyya

Arrange a meeting with children of your Majlis who are studying in 8th, 9th, and 10th grades and introduce them to Jamia Ahmadiyya. For this, help may be taken from the local Missionary or Mu'allim. These children should also be motivated to devote their lives after Matric and seek admission in Jamia Ahmadiyya.

Prescribed books for Study (2025-26)

Majalis should ensure that the following books are studied according to the schedule:

Maal (Finance) Department

1. It is necessary to collect at least the prescribed Chanda from all Atfal members of the Majlis according to the rate set by the Markaz (Center) for the works of the Majlis. Majalis should also try to explain the importance of financial sacrifice to the older children and motivate them to pledge a budget higher than the prescribed rate and ensure its payment.
2. Therefore, it is the responsibility of the Majalis to prepare a budget for all members of their Majlis according to the prescribed rate and Tajneed, and send a copy of this budget to the Markaz.
3. This year, with the approval of Huzoor-e-Anwar (Ayyadahullah Ta‘ala Binasrihil Aziz), the Chanda rates for the members of Majlis Atfal-ul-Ahmadiyya are as follows:
 - Chanda Majlis: Monthly ₹5 (i.e., Annual ₹60)
 - Chanda Ijtema: Annual ₹10
4. 33% of the total Chanda Majlis should be sent to the Markaz, while the remaining 67% may be used for the local works of the Majlis. Proper accounts must be maintained so that the representative of the Markaz can check them. However, the full amount of the Annual Chanda Ijtema must be sent to the Markaz.
5. All Chanda of the Majlis must be received only on the receipt book prescribed by Majlis Khuddam-ul-Ahmadiyya India.
6. During the year, a “Finance Week” (Hafta-e-Maal) should be held once in the Majlis, and during that week, efforts should be made to collect as much Chanda as possible.

Department of Waqf-e-Jadid

During a meeting with the Majlis Amila of Khuddam-ul-Ahmadiyya India, Syedna Huzoor Anwar (Ayyadahullah Ta‘ala Binasrihil Aziz) stated:

“Hazrat Khalifatul Masih II (ra) had entrusted Waqf-e-Jadid to the Department of Atfal-ul-Ahmadiyya. You should also place the responsibility of Waqf-e-Jadid upon the Atfal-ul-Ahmadiyya.

Fix ₹200 for Miyari Awwal (Standard I) and ₹100 for Miyari Dom (Standard II). Prepare a separate special list for them and send it to me. Include everyone else as well.”

(Meeting of Majlis Amila Khuddam-ul-Ahmadiyya Bharat held on 7 January 2005)

In accordance with this instruction of Huzoor Anwar (aba), it is the duty of each Majlis to include all its Atfal in this blessed scheme and, according to the target given by Huzoor Anwar, prepare the list of pledges for the new year and send it to the office by the end of January.

Department of Waqar-e-Amal

1. All Atfal of the Majlis should be encouraged to work with their own hands, such as doing:

- household chores,
- running errands,
- polishing shoes,
- cleaning their homes, rooms, or neighbourhoods, etc.

2. In every Majlis, at least once every month, a collective Waqar-e-Amal (dignity of labour activity) should be held for all Atfal. It is better if, when Khuddam hold their Waqar-e-Amal, the Atfal members are also included at the same time.

3. All Nazimeen Atfal are requested that during every Waqar-e-Amal carried out in your Majalis, you must take one or two photographs and send them via WhatsApp to the Secretary Waqar-e-Amal India or the Muhtamim Atfal India.

Secretary Waqar-e-Amal

Majlis Atfal-ul-Ahmadiyya Bharat

Department of Khidmat-e-Khalq (Service to Humanity)

1. Under the department of Khidmat-e-Khalq, the Atfal of each Majlis should be taken to a nearby government or non-government hospital to visit the sick.
2. Elderly members of the Jamaat who are ill or facing difficulty should be visited by Atfal in small groups of 2–3 children.
3. In the summer season, arrangements should be made for providing cold drinking water in the mosque or at a public place.
4. Atfal should be taught and guided about helping the needy and assisting neighbours.
5. To help poor children in the local area, at least once a year a programme should be organised in which Atfal themselves participate and provide assistance to underprivileged children.

Sehat o Jismani (Department of Physical Health)

Health & Hygiene

At least twice a year, seminars or sessions on health and hygiene should be organised. Parents of Atfal should also be included. During this programme, a doctor or a qualified health expert should explain the principles of hygiene and healthy living to the children.

One Hour of Daily Play

All Atfal of the Majlis should be instructed to spend at least one hour daily outdoors in the ground or compound engaged in some physical game or sport.

Video Games and Mobile Use

Atfal should be regularly informed about the harms of watching unnecessary videos on mobile phones and replacing physical sports with computer or mobile games. This should be monitored throughout the year, and children who show weakness in this regard should be lovingly and consistently guided.

Swimming

According to local conditions and available facilities, a proper arrangement should be made during the summer season to teach swimming to Atfal.

Sports Competitions

Various sports competitions suitable to the age and physical health of Atfal should be organised during the year.

Medical Check-up

At least once a year, all Atfal of the Majlis should undergo a medical check-up, and a report should be sent to the Markaz.

Atfal Competitions (Academic & Sports)

Age Groups (Hizb Classification for Atfal)

- Group A:** Ages 13–15 (Born between 1 November 2010 – 31 October 2013)
- Group B:** Ages 10–12 (Born between 1 November 2013 – 31 October 2016)
